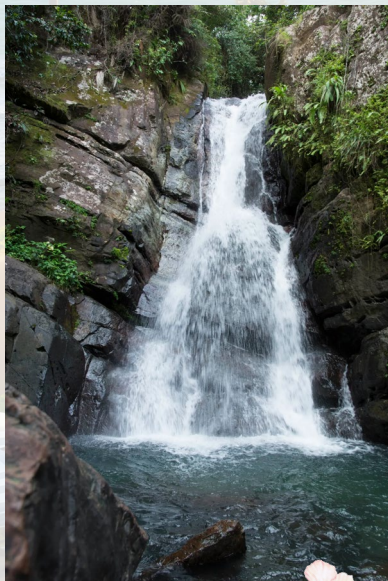
HOSTED GUEST EVENT – EL YUNQUE RAINFOREST TOUR & HIKE *FAMILY FRIENDLY*

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Attire: Comfortable and casual best describe appropriate attire in Puerto Rico. We do suggest a sweater or light jacket for the evenings and comfortable shoes for exploring attractions. Business Casual is suggested for all business and social events. Average temperature during our Meeting is: 85 degrees.

TRANSPORTATION:

Nearby Airport: San Juan Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU) – approximately 45 minutes from Wyndham Grand Rio Mar Resort. Transportation to and from the Resort are on own.

Ground Transportation: Uber is available to/from the Hotel. Taxis service is available, **cash is required for taxi service (average trip is \$70)**. There is an Enterprise car rental at the Hotel should you wish to rent a car during your stay.

CANCELLATION POLICIES:

[Old San Juan](#) – 45 minutes from the Hotel, filled with cobble stone streets and historical Forts that are over 5 centuries old.

[Bioluminescent Bay](#) – Must book this tour 30 days prior to event date. These tours are hosted in the evening, after sundown.

[El Yunque National Forest](#) – If you choose to tour the Rainforest on your own, you must enter in a private car. Ubers or taxi's are not permitted. In addition, you must secure a timed ticket. Tickets and additional information is available 30 days before the day of your planned visit at this website.

[Culebra Island \(Isla Culebra\)](#) – Day trip option to this island offers highly rated beaches with rich history.
